Opportunity Grant program Guidelines



Early Child Education

Opportunity Grant Student Eligibility Definition

1. Washington resident student as defined in [RCW 28B.15.012](#).
2. Enrolled in an Opportunity Grant-eligible program of study.
3. Family income that is at or below 200% of the federal poverty level using the most current guidelines available from the United States Department of Health & Human Services.
4. Financial need based on the FAFSA (Apply for free application for federal student aid prior to applying for grant)
5. Not already have a degree

Program Requirements

1. No student may receive Opportunity Grant funding for more than 45 credits or for more than three years from initial receipt of grant funds in one or a combination of programs. This may include required related courses in a program.
2. The student must maintain a cumulative 2.0 grade point average. If a student's cumulative grade point average falls below 2.0, the student may petition the college. The college has the authority to establish a probationary period until such time as the student's grade point average reaches required standards.
3. An Opportunity Grant-eligible program of study needs to be approved by the State Board for Community and Technical Colleges.

Funding Requirements

Eligible students pursuing approved pathways may receive funds to cover tuition and mandatory fees up to 45 credits and up to \$1,000 for books and supplies for per academic year. Individual student support services is an important part of the program and may include, a single point of contact, one-on-one tutoring, career advising, college success classes, emergency child care, and emergency transportation.

Application Process:

Step1 Ensure you met student eligibility

Step2 Register and enroll in one of the opportunity grant-eligible programs

Step3 Apply for Financial Aid by filling out an on-line application @ WWW.FAFSA.ed.gov **school code is 003787**
