

Do you know of the bus routes that served Seattle Central main campus (as well the Siegal Center nearby)? If not, please see below:

- **Route 8** buses from lower Queen Anne operate weekdays, as often as every 30 minutes, from 6:30 A.M. to 9:30 P.M., stopping at Broadway and E. John Street.
- **Route 9** from Columbia City/Rainier Beach operates during peak hours, as often as every 30 minutes weekdays, and makes stops on Broadway and E. Pine Street.
- **Routes 10 and 11** provide frequent (as often as every 7-10 minutes) and convenient service to campus from downtown Seattle and many areas of Capitol Hill, with stops on Broadway and E. Pine.
- **Route 43** serves the University District and downtown, with stops at Broadway and E. John Street.
- **Route 49** offers service, at 15-minute intervals on weekdays, from downtown Seattle to Capitol Hill and to the University District, making it easy to connect downtown with buses serving many areas of King County. Route 49 buses also make stops at Broadway and E. Pine.
- **Route 60**, departing from White Center to Beacon Hill and continuing to Capitol Hill, offers service, as often as every 30 minutes, from 5:30 a.m. to 9:15 p.m. with stops at Broadway and E. Pine.
- **Route 125** travels between Shorewood, White Center, and downtown Seattle, with service as often as every 15 minutes. Route 125 also serves South Seattle Community College with stops on 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW. Once in downtown Seattle, Route 125 becomes Route 11 providing direct service to Seattle Central Community College, with stops at Broadway and E. Pine.
