- ✓ Regulates permanent and temporary immigration to the US, including tourists or students.
- ✓ Inspects travelers entering (or seeking entry) to the US.
- ✓ Maintains control of U.S. borders.
- ✓ Identifies and removes people who have no lawful immigration status in the U.S.

There are three bureaus under the Department of Homeland Security:

- **Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS)** – Reviews and adjudicates immigration petitions.
- **Bureau of Customs and Border Protection (USCBP)** – Inspects persons seeking to enter the United States.
- **Bureau of Immigration and Customs Enforcement (USICE)** –investigates, detains and removes illegal person (deportation). *USICE also oversees **SEVIS** database.*
