Position Description: Various opportunities. At the Adult Day Health Center sites and Art and Wellness Studio, volunteers support client engagement and staff facilitation of therapeutic, educational and recreational programs in a social environment that nurtures the mind, body, and spirit. At the STAR of Seattle Computer Center, volunteers assist participants with basic computer functions and offer tutoring, including learning about assistive technology.

Qualifications: Strong verbal communication skills (demonstrating attentiveness, patience, and compassion), willingness to take initiative to engage with positive energy and enthusiasm, ability to thrive in dynamic, fast-paced environment, and comfort working in group and team settings.

Total number of weekly hours: Consistent shift for at least one hour/week for a minimum of one academic quarter. Commitment of three months or more is preferred.
