Agency Description: Non-profit organization that works to alleviate hunger and crisis in our community by providing basic human resources such as nutritious food, hygiene items, baby supplies, financial support to avoid eviction or utility shut-off, and other services. Founded in 1989 by a community of citizens concerned about the welfare of their neighbors, it now serves over 3,000 unduplicated households each year and distributes over one million pounds of food through our food bank. Since its inception, the mission has been to help ensure everyone has food on their table and a roof over their head. We strive to deliver our services to those in need with both dignity and respect.

Position Descriptions: A variety of tasks that include: food distribution, client check-in, assisting clients with transportation of their groceries to their cars by carts, restocking food crates on the distribution line, sorting food donations, helping in the baby cupboard area, and assisting with administrative tasks as needed. Volunteers will learn about the great need of social service programs in their community and how their work directly impacts the lives of families, veterans, seniors, and many other individuals in need within our community.
