Agency Description: Teen/Tween Mentorship program for underserved youth

Position Descriptions: Mentor some amazing tweens and teens at Rally Club Seattle!

Activities are tailored to youth interest, and may include arts and crafts, PE type games (relays, dodgeball), pickleball, ping pong, board games, cooking, and more. Mentors may also serve as tutors, helping with homework as needed. We take a collaborative approach to mentorship, with several mentors in place each week.

Responsibilities:

- Come prepared each week by reading weekly plans.
- Spend time each session getting know each youth in the "club" (around 12)
- Be creative and persistent in efforts to engage every child
- Notify Rally Club staff as soon as possible with any schedule issues
- Lead by example and bring energy and enthusiasm to all activities

Days and hours students can serve in this position: Dates/Times:

Tuesdays: 4:15-6:00, Wednesdays 3:00-6:00, Thursdays: 4:15-6:00

Minimum time commitment required of volunteers: One session/week

- Ability to show up consistently and be fully present to each session
- Positive and open attitude
- Willingness to share unique talents and interests
- Non-judgmental attitude towards other cultures, beliefs, and backgrounds.
