## **Agency Description:**

The BTSD Tutoring Program exists to support and empower students by promoting English-language learning, preparing students for the GED test, developing students' self-advocacy skills, and generating community.

#### **Position Descriptions:**

- **Tutors** provide one-on-one assistance to a student who is learning English or preparing for the GED test. Tutors help students understand basic reading, writing, grammatical, or math concepts.
- Classroom Assistants work with classroom teachers in ESL and ABE classes. Classes may focus on reading/writing, speaking/listening, computer skills, math, or communications (basic reading and writing). Classroom assistants provide extra help to students during class time.
- Talk Time Facilitator | Talk Time is meant to create informal spaces for ESL students to practice conversational skills outside their classes and build a sense of belonging at Seattle Central.
