SafeFutures Youth Center is a non-profit youth center in West Seattle, serving middle and high school youth. Many of our young people are immigrants, refugees, or first generation students from predominantly Southeast Asian, East African, African American, Native American/Alaskan Native, Latino, and Pacific Islander backgrounds. SafeFutures has a variety of prevention and intervention programs and services aimed to reduce youth involvement in the juvenile justice system, gangs, and school truancy and drop-out.

**Position Descriptions:**

We are in need of volunteers to assist in the supervision and development of our after school program, that serves approximately 15-25 youth every day. We need volunteers who can help supervise, lead activities, tutor, and are passionate about working with young people.
