<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Emergency</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Imminent risk of harm to oneself or others</li> <li>Acute health condition needing immediate care</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Call 9-1-1!</b></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Behaviors of Concern</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Vague or general concerns</li> <li>Papers/projects containing violent or threatening content which is not part of a class assignment</li> <li>Changes in demeanor, behavior, or appearance</li> <li>Substance abuse</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Non-imminent harm needing immediate response, call Campus Security at (206) 934-5442 or extension 5442.</b></li> <li><b>For concerns that do not need immediate response, contact the Care Team by filling out a <a href="#">Care Report</a>.</b></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Student mentions general thoughts of self-harm or suicide without a plan.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Call King County Crisis Center's 24/7 Crisis Line - Phone 988 or (206) 461-3222, text: 741741, TTY (206) 461-3219 to consult;</b></li> <li><b>Inform your supervisor and the Care Team.</b></li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Student Misconduct</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Disruptive behavior in the classroom/office</li> <li>Plagiarism or cheating</li> <li><a href="#">Conduct report</a> for additional possible violations</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Contact the Student Conduct Office by filling out a <a href="#">Student Conduct Report</a>.</b></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bias/hate incidents</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Contact <a href="#">Central Human Resources</a> or (206) 934-4017 to file a report.</b></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Student who threatens to harm other students, faculty, and staff</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Contact 9-1-1 and <a href="#">Campus Security</a> at (206) 934-5442.</b></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students with weapons on campus</li> <li>Students aggressive to other students/faculty/staff</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Call <a href="#">Campus Security</a> at (206) 934-5442.</b></li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Child Abuse or Neglect</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Physical/verbal abuse of a child or student under age 18.</li> <li>A student tells you about abuse or neglect of anyone under 18.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>All Seattle Central College employees are legally mandated reporters and must immediately contact <a href="#">Child Protective Services</a>.</b></li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Harassment</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A student mentions that an instructor asked her out to lunch off campus to discuss course performance.</li> <li>A student employee is the subject of offensive jokes or ridicule.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Contact <a href="#">Central Human Resources</a> at (206) 934-4017 to file a report.</b></li> </ul>
