VII. Sub-Committee Report Out

- Critical Issues: Dr. Chantae Recasner and Kao Lezheo
 - I. They confirmed their focus will be to examine in person/virtual service and courses
 - II. Their work will be informed by first figuring out how to get good information especially from students.
 - I. May use some research assistants from UW
 - III. This work will integrate perspectives from International Students and Veteran Students and Students with Disabilities.
 - I. We are also working on our OCR Audit finds over the next 6 Years
 - IV. Chisa would also like to make a connection to all students (not just those supported by Mainstay) who felt lost navigating aspects and services around the college
 - V. Critical Issues will also be looking at how we onboard students and making a connection to First Year Experience
