

Enroll in a First Year Learning Community!



A First Year Learning Community is a group of students taking a cluster of courses centered around a theme facilitated by a teaching team. The FYLC setup helps you connect with peers and professors, making learning collaborative and supportive, and encouraging creative and critical thinking.

How to Find and Register for a First Year Learning Community using ctLink?

1. Go to ctLink: **“Student Home Page”**
2. Click: **“Manage Classes”**
3. Click: **“Class Search and Enroll”**
4. Select Quarter and College: Choose **“Fall 2024 Seattle Central College”** from the drop-down menu
5. In the Search for Class box, type **“Learning Communities”**
6. Look over the list of Learning Communities and click on the title that interests you
7. From the **“Class Selection”** column, click the text link to see which two courses you'll earn credit for
8. Click **“Course Information”** for a brief description of the content
9. Click the arrow on the right of the Learning Community you want to enroll in
10. Follow prompts to **“Review the Class Selection”**
11. Click: **“Next”** button in the upper right corner when you are done
12. Do one of the following:
 - a. Check: **“Enroll”** button if you are done searching for classes and are ready to enrollOR
 - a. Check: **“Add to Shopping Cart”** and then the **“Next”** button if you want to continue to search for additional classes
13. Review your selection:
 - a. If you need to make a change, click the **“Previous”** button at the top right
 - b. If everything looks good, click **“Submit.”**
