Agency Description: Fifty percent of children in our state enter kindergarten unprepared. Low-income and immigrant children who enter kindergarten fare even worse at 74% below expected language, communication, and literacy assessments. Denise Louie Education Center provides multicultural early learning and family support services to help prepare Seattle kids and families for kindergarten and success in school and life.

Position Description: Classroom Volunteer

Support classroom teacher and give children a safe and engaging environment for them to learn in. Gain experience working with children, practice teaching skills, and learn different teaching styles. Tasks may include, but are not limited to:

- Reading/storytelling
- Participating in activities
- Keeping the classroom clean and organized
- Doing artwork
- Helping with meal prep
