

## VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY

**Agency Name:** Kline Galland Home

**Agency Description:** Part of the Kline Galland Circle of Care, Kline Galland Home is the only Jewish long-term skilled nursing facility in Washington State and warmly welcomes all faiths. A part of the Seward Park neighborhood for over 100 years, Kline Galland Home currently offers major areas of care: long-term skilled nursing care, short-term care and rehabilitation, memory care and hospice focused care. Residents have the option of engaging in a wide variety of life enrichment activities, such as art, music, games, etc.

**Position Description:** Volunteers support a variety of enriching, stimulating, and fun programs, and enhance the quality of life of residents. Volunteer opportunities include:

- Life Enrichment Programs, supporting a variety of recreational programming (bingo, card and board games; arts and crafts projects; special interest groups)
- Pet Visits
- Caring Companions (1:1 social visits with residents)
- Memory Support Programs, such as challah baking, music, trivia or leading special interest groups
- Hospitality & Visitor Greeting

**Qualifications:** Ideal volunteer candidates are dependable, skilled in communication, willing to engage in active listening, compassionate, and are interested in helping and supporting others. A desire to engage with the elderly and an openness to working in a Jewish environment are important.

**Days/Hours:** Preferred days are Sunday through Friday. Some opportunities are available on Saturdays, but activities are more limited. General recommended volunteer activity times are 10:30 am – 12 pm, 1:30 pm – 4:30 pm, with some scheduled exceptions.

**\*40-60 hour minimum commitment required over the course of 3-6 months**

**Number of openings:** Opportunities consistently available throughout the year

**TB test required prior to start (available on-site at no cost)**

**Other requirements:**

- Passing of background check
- Completion of interview, assessment and onsite orientation training
- Commitment of 40-60 hours (at minimum) of service
- Agreement to adhere to organization policies (i.e., patient confidentiality, etc.)
- Copy of initial 2 dose Covid19 vaccination record
- Proof of current influenza vaccination
