Agency Description: The Eggrolls is a non-hierarchical mutual aid group based out of Little Saigon offering free meals and basic needs items (clothing, medical, etc.) to community members. The group distributes these items every Sunday morning without fail, relying on principles of mutual aid (i.e., democratic decision-making, solidarity over charity, etc.) to guide operations. Volunteers engage in a variety of ways (i.e., item distribution, trash pick-up, deescalation support, etc.). All volunteers meet on-site in advance of the distribution to engage in introductions, a brief training, and role sign-ups. The Eggrolls are chiefly concerned with engaging unhoused neighbors, Asian elders from the community, and anyone else who participates.

Position Descriptions: Food distribution (handing out food, which requires an active WA state food-handler permit), Supplies distribution (handing out clothes, basic medical resources, etc.), Line greeting (managing the flow of neighbors through the volunteer site), Trash pick-up (picking up trash/recycling items on and around the volunteer site), and Safety de-escalation (support conflict de-escalation between neighbors when it occurs)

Days and hours students can serve in this position: 10:30am-12:30pm on Sundays

Minimum time commitment required of volunteers: There is no minimum time commitment

What qualities, abilities and skills are important to your agency? We ask *individuals who will be handling food* to have an active WA state food-handler permit. (Not everyone handles food.) Individuals who speak the most common non-English languages used on site (i.e., Cantonese, Mandarin, Spanish, Vietnamese, etc.) can be of great support for linguistic interpretation.

Is volunteer orientation provided? No

Length of time students should budget for it: Being present from 10:30am to 12:30pm for the totality of Sunday distribution is encouraged but not required. The Eggrolls group tends to share a free meal together afterwards as well, for those interested \bigcirc

Is volunteer training provided? A pre-volunteering huddle occurs at the beginning of each Sunday morning distribution. Individuals interested in a more involved description of the activities in advance of volunteering are encouraged to reach out to the Eggrolls email (theeggrollcrew@gmail.com) to ask additional questions.

Length of time students should budget for it: 2 hours per Sunday

Is on-site supervision provided? Yes: a buddy system is always employed during Sunday distributions to support peer-to-peer connection and safety.
