Agency Description: The Danny Woo Community Garden was founded in 1975 and is located in Seattle's Chinatown-International District. The Garden is approximately 2 acres and contains about 80 plots that are cultivated and cared for by elderly Asian immigrant residents of the neighborhood. The garden is also home to a children's garden, chicken coop, outdoor kitchen, and fruit tree orchard. As the largest green space in the neighborhood, the Garden is an essential place for the surrounding community to engage with nature, access safe and healthy food, and build cohesion with neighbors. The Garden was created for community by community, and InterIm CDA works to maintain its existence as a resource for the gardeners, the CID community, and the general public.

Position Descriptions: Volunteers assist with garden maintenance tasks such as weeding, compost turning, litter pick up, and fruit collection as well as special projects on an as-needed basis such as cleaning the chicken coop, carpentry, native plant planting,

Days and hours students can serve in this position: Tues-Thursday, 10am-3pm
