Agency Description:

The Youth Tutoring Program is an after-school educational enrichment program for first through twelfth grade students who live in five low-income housing communities in Seattle.

Position Descriptions:

Each volunteer tutor commits to weekly tutoring sessions(s) at one of our seven tutoring centers a minimum of 1 hour a week while most students volunteer 2 hours a week. During the one-hour tutoring session, volunteer tutors work one on one or in small groups with students on reading, skill building in math and English Language Arts, and homework help. Volunteers also serve as role models and mentors to the students because tutors work with the same students each week. YTP students are diverse, representing many cultures, languages and religions.

Days and hours students can serve in these positions:

With a few exceptions, tutoring happens Monday – Thursday, with three sessions each: 4:20 pm – 5:20 pm; 5:30 pm – 6:30 pm; 6:40 pm – 7:40 pm

Minimum time commitment required of volunteers:

1-2 hours/week for the quarter (volunteers are encouraged to continue volunteering beyond the academic quarter as the program and students benefit)

1. Be compassionate, consistent, and flexible! 2. Have the desire to help make a difference in the lives of youth. 3. Have experience tutoring school-age youth or an interest in learning the skills necessary to be a successful tutor. (Free training provided)
