Instructions:

- 1. Apply for admissions at Seattle Central College in-person or online. We are unable to process transcript evaluation requests if a student has not applied to our campus.
- 2. Attend an information session and/or meet an advisor for your intended program. If you do not have applicable coursework, you may not need to complete this process.
- 3. Submit applicable official transcripts and/or exam scores (i.e. Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate) to the Admissions Office. They must be received in a sealed envelope as issued by the originating institution or sent electronically by the issuing institution. Emailed, faxed or opened transcripts are considered unofficial and will not be used for evaluation.

If you attended North Seattle College, South Seattle College or Seattle Vocational Institute, you do <u>not</u> need to request official transcripts **but please list below if applicable**. Courses completed at Seattle Central College do not require an evaluation. If you have submitted official transcripts to any of the aforementioned colleges, you can contact their respective Registration Offices to have your records forwarded to Seattle Central.
