**Days and hours students can serve in this position:** day and time flexible. We have virtual and in-person volunteer opportunities most nights of the week, as well as daytime events on weekends and time-flexible remote volunteer roles.

**Minimum time commitment required of volunteers:** 3hrs/month

**Is volunteer orientation provided?** Yes

**Length of time students should budget for it:** 45-min new volunteer orientation at the beginning of our monthly potluck & social (called Climate Community Night), on third Thursdays, from 6:15-8:30pm. We rotate locations around the city.

**Is volunteer training provided?** Yes

**Length of time students should budget for it:** Yes! If you sign up for a skill-based role or task like canvassing or testifying at City Hall, you will receive training and mentorship. However, not all roles require training. For instance, we welcome you to show up to our community education events and actions. And there's plenty of roles like helping put on our monthly Climate Community Night, where you'll work with a team and learn 'on the job'.
