Agency Description: Public utility districts (PUDs) are consumer-owned entities that provide services across the country. They provide cleaner energy, at cheaper cost for residents. They serve millions of customers in Washington and have done so for almost 100 years. PUDs are governed by a publicly elected Commission made up of registered voters from the area. They are operated for and by the people they serve. PSE is a privately-owned for-profit monopoly that has higher rates, dirtier energy, and less transparency than a PUD. Our campaign is working to replace them with a PUD. We can do this by citizen ballot initiative. We must collect 30,000 signatures of registered voters in the PUD area between January and July 2022 and then educate voters about this important issue ahead of the General Election in November 2022.

Position Descriptions:

- **Social media manager/scheduler** – find and schedule social media content on behalf of the campaign.
- **Writer** – create posts, letters to the editor, op-eds, in support of the campaign
- **In-person campaign activities** – flyering, sign waving, door knocking
- **Remote campaign activities** – letter-writing/postcarding, text/phone banking
- **Pick your own adventure** – tell us what you'd like to do!

Days and hours students can serve in this position: varies – depends on how deeply the student wants to engage, whether someone wants to devote 2 hours or 16+ hours. Days and times will also vary.
