Bailey-Boushay House

Type of positions: Provide support to clients and residents; assist staff at meal times and with activities and outings

Agency Description: A nationally recognized facility in Seattle offering residential care and chronic care management for people with HIV, AIDS, and other terminal illnesses

Bloodworks Northwest

Type of positions: Donor monitor and donor registration

Agency Description: Blood donation center

Chinese Information and Service Center

Type of position: After School Tutor

Agency Description: Non-profit agency serving the Chinese community by providing information and assistance and direct social and support services

Community Lunch on Capitol Hill

Type of position: Help prepare and serve meals

Agency Description: Meal program

Denise Louie Education Center

Type of positions: Classroom assistant and office assistant

Agency Description: Non-profit Head Start program

East African Community Services

Type of position: Tutor

Agency Description: Agency dedicated to improving the well-being and quality of life for East African youth and their families

Entre Hermanos

Type of positions: Various – to include making condom kits, clerical, voter education, event organizing, assisting w/classes, and more

Agency Description: Promote the health and well-being of the Latino Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual, Transgender, and questioning community through disease prevention, education, support services and advocacy

FareStart

Type of positions: Kitchen Prep, Shelter Meal Delivery,

Agency Description: A culinary and life skills training and placement program for individuals fighting their way out of poverty

First Covenant Church – The Breakfast Club

Type of position: Students can set up, cook, serve and clean up at breakfast for homeless and low income families

Agency Description: Provides breakfast every Saturday for the homeless and low-income residents in Seattle

Full Life Care

Type of positions: Activity assistants

Agency Description: Adult daycare center, some developmentally disabled clients. Also operate the STAR Center (a public computer center with assistive technology)

Homage Senior Services

Type of positions: Spanish, Laotian, Vietnamese and Korean translators and interpreters

Agency Description: The Senior Companion Program is one of the services they provide to their clients

Horn of Africa Services

Type of position: Tutor

Agency Description: A multi-lingual, multi-cultural non-profit organization offering support and advocacy services to East African refugees and immigrants living in the greater Seattle area

InterimCDA – Danny Wood Garden

Type of position: Community Garden Assistant, translators, and Garden Preschool Teacher's Assistant

Agency Description: The Danny Woo Garden (managed by Interim) is a unique urban park which provides garden plots to elderly, low income residents of the International District

Jewish Family Service

Type of positions: Food bank assistance and assist with other projects

Agency Description: Family service agency

Kawabe Memorial House

Type of positions: Serve lunch, assist with activities and help with translation

Agency Description: Provides affordable housing and culturally sensitive services to people 62 years of age and older, generally first generation immigrants from Asia

Legacy House

Type of position: Activity Assistant

Agency Description: Non-profit assisted living and adult day center for low-income seniors.

Lifelong

Type of positions: Meal bagging team, kitchen and warehouse helpers, office support, and more

Agency Description: A leader in the fight against HIV and AIDS since 1983

Lifelong Thrift Store

Type of position: Thrift store volunteer

Agency Description: Operated by Lifelong - - proceeds are used to fund services for their clients

Mary's Place

Type of positions: Various positions in day centers and shelters

Agency Description: Empowering homeless women, children, and families to reclaim their lives by providing shelter, nourishment, resources, healing and hope in a safe community

North Helpline

Type of positions: Food sorting and distribution, client check-in, restocking and possibly administrative tasks

Agency Description: Provides basic human resources such as food, hygiene items, baby supplies, and some financial support to avoid utility shut-off

Northwest Harvest – Cherry Street Food Bank

Type of position: Sort, package and distribute food

Agency Description: Food bank

Oxbow Farm and Conservation Center

Type of position: Kid's Farm Naturalist and Habitat Restoration Volunteer

Agency Description: Non-profit farm in the Snoqualmie Valley that inspires people to eat healthy, sustainably grown food and to manage natural resources for future generations

Pacific Science Center

Type of positions: Guest experience volunteer, data entry, science interpretation, and more

Agency Description: Brings science to life through hands-on exhibits and activities

Pike Market Food Bank

Type of positions: Help collect food donations, receive and process food deliveries, assist clients with food choices

Agency Description: Downtown food bank serves over 1000 households per week

Puget Sound Labor Agency Food Bank

Type of positions: Food bank greeter; shelf re-stocker; and non-cook room assistant

Agency Description: Founded in 1975 by local labor unions to serve their neighbors and to give back to their community

Rainier Valley Food Bank

Type of position: Food bank volunteer

Agency Description: Food bank in one of the most ethnically diverse zip codes

Reading Partners

Type of position: Reading Program Literacy volunteer

Agency Description: Expands life opportunities for underserved elementary school children by empowering them with strong literacy skills

St. James Cathedral

Type of positions: Kitchen volunteer for meal program for low-income individuals and winter shelter overnight volunteer

Agency Description: A parish church that provides outreach to those who live on the edge of poverty and loneliness

SCC: Basic and Transitional Studies

Type of position: Tutor; classroom assistant

Agency Description: ESL and Adult Basic Education programs in a college environment

SCC: Global Engagement Team (GET)

Type of position: Conversation Partner

Agency Description: GET is a Student Leadership board dedicated to providing opportunities for intl and domestic students to meet and make connections

SCC: Mitchell Activity Center

Type of position: Varies – depending on needs

Agency Description: College activity center

SCC: Outreach

Type of positions: Assist with campus tours, outreach events and general office duties

Agency Description: Outreach to, and recruitment of, potential students

Soccer Without Borders

Type of position: Assistant Soccer Coach

Agency Description: Uses soccer as a vehicle for change to help create a safe space where children of all backgrounds can have fun, grow and build confidence

Society of St. Vincent de Paul Food Bank

Type of positions: Warehouse, food bank, and recycling – Georgetown location

Agency Description: Serves 150,000 people annually in home visits, case management, food bank, and related programs

Ten Thousand Villages

Type of positions: Sales; customer service; inventory

Agency Description: Fair trade retail store

The Food Bank at St. Mary's

Type of position: Sort and distribute food

Agency Description: Emergency food program

The Unity Museum

Type of positions: Exhibit research/development; tech support; program development; outreach; museum management; archive/library operations

Agency Description: A museum dedicated to understanding our common historical heritage, as well as promoting racial, gender and income equality, universal education, and peaceful resolution of conflict

Tiny Trees Preschool

Type of position: Working with preschool-age children – support teachers, children and families

Agency Description: Outdoor preschool

University District Food Bank

Type of positions: Help with the operation of the food bank and/or assist with assembly and delivery of food parcels

Agency Description: Provide individuals and families who are in need with food and access to network of community resources

Urban Impact

Type of positions: Tutor

Agency Description: Non-profit agency that has been a consistent presence in the Rainier Valley. Their mission is to break the cycle of social, material and spiritual poverty in urban neighborhoods.

Vietnamese Friendship Association

Type of position: Tutor

Agency Description: Provides school day, after school and Saturday tutoring for Seattle World School students

Washington Talking Book & Braille Library

Type of position: Shipping Assistant

Agency Description: Provides state-wide library services (at the library and by mail) to any WA resident unable to read standard print material due to blindness, visual impairment, or physical or reading disability

YouthCare

Type of position: Safe Place Response Team

Agency Description: YouthCare provides comprehensive services that help young people experiencing homelessness achieve long-term stability – Provides prevention services, street outreach, engagement centers, shelter, housing and education/training programs
