Little Bit is a non-profit organization that offers a unique approach to therapy. Adults and children with physical, emotional, or cognitive disabilities from the greater Puget Sound area are enrolled in weekly adaptive horseback riding classes and /or hippotherapy treatments that improve physical health, provide a sense of accomplishment, control, and emphasize the capabilities of each participant.
